June 15 (9:00 – 4:00)	NEGA RESA Room C	<b>Platform Sustainability Training</b> *Required training session is for a targeted audience. No online registration.
June 15 - 17 (8:30 – 3:30)	NEGA RESA Room B	<b>LKES District Sustainability</b> For a targeted audience including district-level personnel and school administrators to be trained as LKES District Credentialed Trainers.
July 7 - 9 (8:30 – 3:30)	NEGA RESA Room C	<b>TKES Credentialing</b> For principals, assistant principals, or designated evaluators who will complete an evaluation on teachers in the school building/district. In order to evaluate teachers using TKES, the leader must hold TKES Credentialing as designated by GaDOE. The TKES Evaluator Training and Credentialing is a 3-day course, and in order to complete the credentialing portion of the training, you must attend all 3 days of training.
July 23 - 24 (8:30 – 3:30)	NEGA RESA Room A	<b>LKES Credentialing</b> In order to evaluate principals or assistant principals, an evaluator must hold LKES Credentialing as designated by GaDOE. The LKES Evaluator Training and Credentialing is for all district leaders, principals, and designated evaluators who will complete an evaluation on principals or assistant principals. The LKES Evaluator Training and Credentialing is designed as a 2-day course. However, if you already hold TKES Credentialing, you may opt out of the second day, and complete credentialing using the online assessment. If you are not already credentialed in TKES, you will need to attend both days of training in order to complete the LKES credentialing. <b>Please note:</b> Participants credentialing in both TKES and LKES should complete TKES training prior to LKES training.
July 28 - 30 (8:30 – 3:30)	NEGA RESA Room C	<b>TKES Credentialing</b> For principals, assistant principals, or designated evaluators who will complete an evaluation on teachers in the school building/district. In order to evaluate teachers using TKES, the leader must hold TKES Credentialing as designated by GaDOE. The TKES Evaluator Training and Credentialing is a 3-day course, and in order to complete the credentialing portion of the training, you must attend all 3 days of training.
